

Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	<p>The Amendment Regulation will also amend the <i>Justices Regulation 2014</i> and the <i>Criminal Practice Rules 1999</i> to provide that when documents are being provided to an Australian court (including the family law courts and state and territory courts) or tribunal, no fee is payable.</p> <p>The Amendment Regulation amends the <i>Domestic and Family Violence Protection Rules 2014</i> to provide that the requirements in rule 47(3) do not apply to a request for information from an Australian court under s160 of the <i>Domestic and Family Violence Protection Act 2012</i>, to allow court documents to be shared with the family law courts or the court or tribunal of another state or territory without a written request. The Regulation also includes technical amendments.</p> <p>The proposal relates to the administration of courts and is not subject to regulatory impact analysis requirements under the Better Regulation Policy.</p>
