Arrival Times

All visitors must present to Visit Processing no less than one hour (60 minutes) prior to commencement of visits. All visitors ove the age of 18 years must be enrolled in the biometric identification system at the centre. The maximum number of visitors per prisoner is as follows:

3 adults and 4 children (contact visit) or 3 adults and 2 children (non contact visit).

Other Information

Tobacco and other smoking related products are prohibited items within a correctional centre. Tobacco and other smoking related products must not be taken into a correctional centre and must be either secured in a motor vehicle or visitor locker. No smoking is permitted anywhere in the grounds of a correctional centre, including car parks, walkways, visits processing etc.

Mobile phones are not permitted within the correctional centres. Mobile phones must be left in vehicles or lockers provided at visits processing. Any mobile phones brought into the correctional centres may be confiscated.

There are no toilet facilities available at the prisoner visits area. Toilet facilities are available in the Administration Building for visitors to use before and after their visit session. Personal lockers are available for visitors in the foyer of the visits area. Visitors are advised that there are requirements in regard to dress and behaviour standards that must be adhered to.

Nappies need to be provided by the visitor [two only]. Visitors may bring in one bottle containing pre-mixed formula only and one bib (containers are not permitted). No hand washing facilities are available inside the centre. No money or drinks permitted into the centre.

COVID restrictions

Visitors are no longer required to wear a face mask. A visitor may be directed to wear a face mask where they display cold or flu like symptoms. Visiting restrictions remain in place if a visitor is a COVID diagnosed person or COVID close contact.
