**Activity:** Deployment of seabed mounted current monitoring instrument.

Mariners are advised that:

From 5<sup>th</sup> December 2023 a current and wave monitoring instrument has been deployed in approximate position latitude 14° 59.433′ S, longitude 145° 20.933′E. The equipment is rigged on a Sea Spider frame with height off the seabed of 0.53 metres and a diameter of the three (3) legs of 1.47 metres. Water depth at the site is about 10-12 metres. The deployment includes a trailing line and anchor system for retrieval. From the 24<sup>th</sup> January 2024 a surface buoy will be established in position with characteristics, Fl Y 2.5s.

Deployment will be for a period of approximately 12 months until 31st December 2024.
