Applications for the 2024–2025
Community-based Crime Action grants
open on 17 June 2024, offering double
the funding.

The combined Rounds 1 and 2 increase
available funding to \$2.5 million and
opportunities for more successful
applications.

Grants of up to \$75,000 will be available per
successful application, and you can submit
two applications for consecutive iterations
of the same project.

Community-based Crime Action grants
support local communities, businesses
and organisations with short-term programs
and initiatives that engage young people
and deliver early intervention, prevention,
and diversionary solutions to address local
youth crime and community concerns.

These grants aim to keep communities
safe by reducing youth crime and helping
young people involved in the youth justice
system to build positive relationships and
participation in their communities.

Prospective applicants are encouraged to
consult with their community and engage
local stakeholders to consider proposals.
