- · MUST be correctly enrolled as electors of the State of Queensland (if the applicant is a resident of Queensland).
- \cdot MUST have achieved competency through a Registered Training Organisation.
- MUST agree to comply with the Code of Conduct for Justices of the Peace and Commissioners for Declarations.
- MUST advise the Justices of the Peace Branch if you have ever held an occupational licence that has been suspended or revoked or have been disqualified from holding an occupational licence.

Eligibility for Appointment:

- You are not eligible for appointment if:
 - · You are an insolvent under administration.
 - You have a disqualifying conviction. (Applicants may apply for an exemption from a disqualifying conviction please see notes below for more information.)
 - · You have had a previous appointment as a Justice of the Peace or Commissioner for Declarations revoked within the last 5 years.

Referees:

- \cdot MUST be persons of good standing in the community.
- MUST have known you well for more than 3 years (do not include referees who have known you for less than 3 years).
- · MUST reside in Australia.
- \cdot MUST NOT be relatives by either birth or marriage.
- \cdot MUST NOT be members of the Police Service.

• You must forward a referee report form to BOTH of your selected referees and collect the forms when they are completed. Please attach your completed reports to your application form.

The application and referee reports are to be lodged with your nominator, who will check them and forward them to the Department of Justice and Attorney-General.
