

Travel approval application - harvested rangeland goats

Pursuant to section 181 of the Biosecurity Act 2014

Purpose of this form

To apply for travel approval to move harvested rangeland goats directly to slaughter or via one registered goat depot within Queensland **without** an approved NLIS device.

Travel approval eligibility

A harvested rangeland goat is defined as a goat that has been captured from a wild state, has not been born as a result of a managed breeding program, and has not been subjected to any animal husbandry procedure or treatment. Any goat that does not meet this definition requires an approved NLIS device prior to leaving its property.

Harvested rangeland goats **must not** be moved unless a travel approval is issued by an Inspector appointed under the *Biosecurity Act 2014*.

To be eligible applicants must have:

 A current biosecurity entity registration that includes managed goats and harvested rangeland goats on the Property Identification Code/s (PIC) intended for capture. The applicant must be associated to the PIC/s as a landowner or authorised user.

Harvested rangeland goat NLIS device free movement

If your travel approval application is successful you can provide it to Livestock Production Assurance (LPA) as part of the LPA harvested rangeland goat accreditation process. The Queensland Department of Agriculture and Fisheries travel approval provides authorisation to LPA to assign harvested rangeland goat status to the accredited PIC.

How long does the travel approval last?

If your travel approval is successful, it will have the same expiry as your biosecurity entity registration. You will need to reapply for a travel approval if your biosecurity entity registration expires or is renewed.
