Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 31 October 2024

Area: Brisbane pilotage area
Locality: Weinman Creek Redland Bay
Activity: Dredging operations

Mariners are advised that:

Dredging operations in Weinman Creek will commence on Wednesday 13 November 2024 in Weinman Creek and approaches with works expected to be completed by April 2025.

Works will involve the hopper dredge "PORT FREDERICK" and support operations including commercial dive teams under marina pontoons and excavator on spudded barge. All operations will be conducted during daylight hours with the PORT FREDERICK to transfer all dredged material to Mud Island deposition site. Pipeline between commercial diving dredge works and PORT FREDERICK will be submerged on shallow seabeds marked by lit buoyage out of the marked navigation channel.

The vessels will display appropriate day shapes and lights at night for safe passing sides and will spud within the works area at night, maintaining navigational access.

Mariners should navigate with caution, maintain a safe distance off, and operate at minimum speed and wash in the vicinity of these works for the safety of the work site.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA2020 datum.
