**Activity:** Dredging Operations

Mariners are advised that:

Maintenance dredging operations will be conducted at the eastern end of the Redcliffe Jetty in approximate position latitude 27°13.567'S longitude 153°07.060'E.

Works will be carries out from Monday, 28 April 2025 to Friday, 30 May 2025 by the grab dredge vessel 'Ken Harvey' and support craft. Hours of work will be Monday to Friday 0600 hours to 1800 hours and Saturdays if required. All associated vessels will monitor VHF channels 13 and 16 and will exhibit regulation lights, day shapes and signals as required.

The dredge will use a system of six (6) anchors marked with buoys to maintain position and the master will monitor vessel traffic to allow vessels to berth and depart where required. Each buoy is yellow in colour and will display light characteristics Q FI 1.5s at night.

To support operations, two (2) anchors marked with buoys will be located approximately 200m east of the breakwater in approximate positions latitude 27°13.493'S longitude 153°07.211'E and latitude 27°13.664'S longitude 153°07.235'E for two barges to be moored when not in operation. The barges will be attached to the buoys at night and display an all-round white light between sunset and sunrise.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the area and maintain a safe distance.
