

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 15 February 2024

Area: Brisbane pilotage area
Locality: Centenary Bridge, Brisbane River
Activity: Temporary aids to navigation established

Mariners are advised that:

Piling barge works at the Centenary Bridge will require the relocation of the navigation channel from spans 3 and 4 to spans 4 and 5. The relocation will be for a period of approximately 1 to 2 weeks commencing Thursday 15 February 2024.

The new navigation channel will be demarcated by port and starboard buoys:

- A port buoy displaying characteristics Fl. R 2.5s, in the approximate position 27°31.646'S, 152°56.859'E.
- A starboard buoy displaying characteristics Fl. G 2.5s, in the approximate position 27°31.631'S, 152°56.869'E.
- A port buoy displaying characteristics Fl. R 2.5s, in the approximate position 27°31.633'S, 152°56.747'E.
- A starboard buoy displaying characteristics Fl. G 2.5s, in the approximate position 27°31.622'S, 152°56.744'E.

The barge operator will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 13 and display an all-round white light in conjunction with quick flashing yellow lights on the corners between sunset and sunrise and during conditions of restricted visibility.

Mariners should navigate with caution when transiting the area.
