**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT OF LAND DESIGNATED  
FOR COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE  
MADE UNDER THE *SUSTAINABLE PLANNING ACT 2009***

An amendment of land designated for community infrastructure has been made by a Minister

I, Mark Bailey MP, Minister for Energy and Water Supply, give notice that I have amended a corridor of land designated earlier for community infrastructure under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009* Chapter 5, by

- removing some land and easements from the earlier designation.

The earlier designation was notified in the Queensland Government Gazette on 30 November 2012 as land on which ENERGEX Limited proposes to build a 110 kilovolt sub-transmission line from Powerlink Queensland's Loganlea Substation to ENERGEX Limited's Jimboomba Substation and connection of the line into the Loganlea, Kingston and Jimboomba Substations.

**Reason for amendment**

The reason for the amendment to the earlier designation is a redesign of the designated alignment to enable ENERGEX Limited to move a section of the proposed 110 kilovolt powerline into the road reserve on the southern side of Camp Cable Road between Travis and Edelsten Roads.

## MAJOR AMENDMENT TO THE BALONNE SHIRE PLANNING SCHEME – FLOODING REGULATION

Notice is given under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, Section 117 – 120 and in accordance with the requirements of *Statutory Guideline 01/14 – Making and amending a local planning instrument*, that on 21st August 2015 Balonne Shire Council adopted a Major Amendment to the existing Balonne Shire Planning Scheme 2006 (the Major Amendment).

The purpose and general effect of the Major Amendment is to address potential impacts and improve resilience of the townships of St George and Bollon by refining the desired land use intent in these areas and to adjust the level of assessment for future development accordingly.
