

## Gifts and Benefits Register – Quarter 3, January to March 2019

Any gift or benefit received or given that has a retail value of more than \$150 must be recorded in a gifts and benefits register.

If multiple gifts\* are from the same donor or from donors in a similar relationship with the public service employee, in any financial year and the cumulative value is more than \$150, then each gift or benefit must be reported.
