Who we are

The First Nations Justice Office is a small team from the Department of Justice and Attorney-General with staff based in Cairns, Townsville and Brisbane.

We have partnered with izi Global, an Indigenous owned and led organisation to talk to people about justice for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

What we are doing

We are talking to people to help co-design a whole-of-government and community strategy to have less Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in the justice system.

We want to make sure the voices of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples are heard to change this and help make a better tomorrow for our people and communities.

Why we are doing this

The National Agreement on Closing the Gap is a commitment by government to improve the lives of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

There are too many Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in the justice system.

This includes being in trouble with police, going to court or in prison.

This also includes being victim-survivors of crime and domestic and family violence.
