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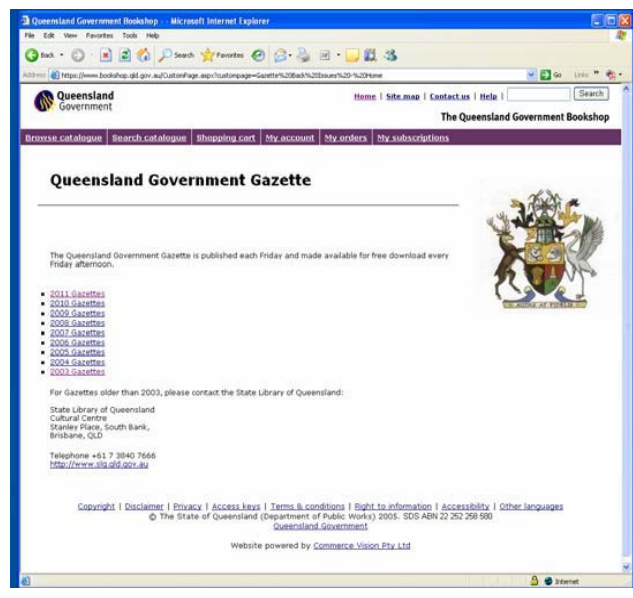
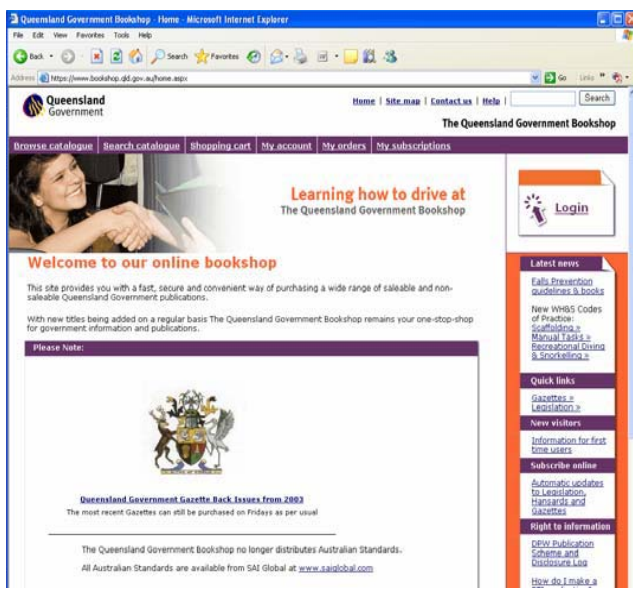

**Statutory Guideline 02/12

I, the Honourable Jeff Seeney MP, Deputy Premier and Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning do hereby notify under section 117 of the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009* (the Act) that on 30 October 2012 I approved *Statutory Guideline 02/12 Making and amending local planning instruments*.

On 15 November 2012, the Governor in Council approved the amending of the *Sustainable Planning Regulation 2009*. On 16 November 2012 the subordinate legislation *Sustainable Planning Amendment Regulation (No. 7) 2012* was notified in the Queensland Government Gazette and, *Statutory Guideline 02/12 Making and amending local planning instruments* became effective.

The above actions have repealed *Statutory Guideline 01/12 Making and amending local planning instruments* dated 16 January 2012.
