 TEMPORARY LOCAL PLANNING INSTRUMENT 01/13—  
 ST GEORGE AND BOLLON FLOODING REGULATION  
 FOR THE BALONNE SHIRE PLANNING SCHEME**

Notice is given under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, Sections 105-107, that on 8 August 2013 Balonne Shire Council adopted a Temporary Local Planning Instrument 01/13 - St George and Bollon Flooding Regulation (TLPI 01/13).

The purpose and general effect of TLPI 01/13 is to address potential impacts and improve resilience of the townships of St George and Bollon by refining the desired land use intent in these areas and to adjust the level of assessment for future development accordingly.

TLPI 01/13 includes a St George and Bollon Flood Regulation Code which applies to development occurring in the Flood Hazard Areas. This provides for specific planning provisions to more appropriately manage planning and development outcomes in these areas.

The St George Flood Hazard Area relates to premises included in the defined area on Map 1A. The Bollon Flood Hazard Area relates premises included in the defined area on Map 2A.

TLPI 01/13 will have effect on and from 19 August 2013 and will cease to have effect on 18 August 2014 or when it is repealed in accordance with the provisions of the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*.

**ADOPTION OF MAJOR AMENDMENT TO THE FITZROY SHIRE  
 PLANNING SCHEME 2005 (REPRINT 3)**

Notice is given in accordance with Section 117(1) of the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, that on 13 August 2013 Rockhampton Regional Council adopted the Major Amendment to the Fitzroy Shire Planning Scheme 2005 (Reprint 3).

The amendments to the Fitzroy Shire Planning Scheme 2005 will have effect on and from 19 August 2013. The main effect of the major amendment was to include a new zone structure and planning provisions for parts of the Gracemere - Stanwell zone, in particular precincts B, C, D, J and K. These precinct boundaries have been amended to create a new clearly defined low impact industry precinct, medium impact industry precinct and high impact industry precinct. The major amendment includes:

- (1.) updated zone mapping (Maps A2, A8, A9 and A17);
- (2.) changes to the Gracemere - Stanwell zone code tables of assessment;
- (3.) changes to the Gracemere - Stanwell zone code intent statements;
- (4.) changes to the Gracemere - Stanwell zone code performance outcome provisions;
- (5.) changes to other relevant codes in the planning scheme; and
- (6.) refinement of desired environmental outcomes related to industry and economic development.
