

Better Local Business Grant

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is eligible for this grant program?

- Small and family business associations/groups
- Industry associations
- Chambers of Commerce and Industry
- Local councils

Am I eligible to receive funding for an event if I am a small and family business?

No, small or family businesses are not eligible to receive funding to host an event or activity themselves. However, if they are part of an eligible group, they may be authorised to participate in the organisation of an event or activity on behalf of the group.

How much money can my organisation apply for as part of the Better Local Business Grant program?

Eligible organisations will be able to access fixed up-front grant funding of \$2,500 (excluding GST).

How will the grants be assessed?

Grants will be assessed on the activity's potential to address local business concerns or opportunities and positively impact the local small and family business community, including its ability to foster networks that extend beyond Queensland Small Business Month.

If my grant is not approved can I appeal?

These grant decisions cannot be appealed.
