Mariners are advised that:

Fireworks display will be conducted from a barge stationed within Auckland Creek adjacent to the Port Curtis Sailing Club on the following days and times:

- Thursday, 17 April 2025 from 1940 hours to 2000 hours
- Saturday, 19 April 2025 from 2100 hours to 2120 hours
- Sunday, 20 April 2025 from 2035 hours to 2055 hours

To ensure safety to mariners, the fireworks display launching barge will be secured to the pylons at the position of 23°50.144′S and 151°21.357′ E. An exclusion zone of 62.5 m will be enforced around this position. The safety zone will extend from the firing position along the high-water mark of Auckland Creek to imaginary line west from East Shores jetty and the O'Connell Wharf. (see attached map A1-575)

Queensland Water Police – Gladstone will be in attendance to monitor river traffic and enforce the safety and exclusion zone imposed by the Queensland Explosives Inspectorate.

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution when transiting the area.


