MAPOON ABORIGINAL SHIRE COUNCIL COUNCILLOR BY-ELECTION SATURDAY 15 APRIL 2023



On 3 March 2023, a Notice of Election was issued to hold a by-election to fill a vacancy in the office of councillor in the Mapoon Aboriginal Shire Council on 1 April 2023. As no candidate nominations were received for the by-election, the proceedings for the by-election must start again in accordance with section 34(2) of the *Local Government Electoral Act 2011*.

On 17 March 2023, a Notice of Election was published fixing 15 April 2023 as the new polling day as detailed below.

Polling booths will be open on election day from 8am to 6pm. **Voting is compulsory.**

Candidate nominations are open from Friday, 17 March 2023 and close at 12pm (noon) on Monday, 27 March 2023.

Council is willing to negotiate to acquire by agreement, or failing agreement, to treat as to the compensation to be paid and all consequential matters.

If the land is taken, then a claim for compensation may be served on Council only within three years after the day the land is taken.

Council may accept, and deal with, a claim for compensation served by you more than three years after the land is taken if Council is satisfied it is reasonable in all the circumstances to do so.

If Council does not accept a claim served by you more than three years after the land is taken, you may apply to the Land Court to decide whether it is reasonable in all the circumstances for Council to accept the claim.

Section 20(2) of the *Acquisition of Land Act 1967*

Section 20(2A) of the *Acquisition of Land Act 1967* provides that, in assessing compensation, a contract, licence, agreement or other arrangement (relevant instrument) entered into in relation to the land after the notice of intention to resume was served on you must not be taken into consideration if the relevant instrument was entered into for the sole or dominant purpose of enabling you or another person to obtain compensation for an interest in land created under the relevant instrument.
