**NOTICE OF REPEAL OF TEMPORARY LOCAL PLANNING INSTRUMENT No. 2 of 2022 –
CABOOLTURE WEST EMERGING COMMUNITY AREA (TLPI 02/2022)
MORETON BAY REGIONAL COUNCIL LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA**

I, the Honourable Steven Miles MP, Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning, and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure, notify that I repeal TLPI 02/2022 in accordance with section 27 of the *Planning Act 2016* and the Minister's Guidelines and Rules version 1.1. The repeal of TLPI 02/2022 will take effect at the end of the day on Monday 13 March 2023.

Purpose and General Effect

TLPI 02/2022 is a temporary local planning instrument under section 23 of the *Planning Act 2016* that took effect on 29 September 2022. Under section 23(3) of the *Planning Act 2016*, a temporary local planning instrument may suspend or otherwise affect the operation of another local planning instrument but does not amend or repeal the instrument.

The purpose of TLPI 02/2022 is to:

- support a future planning framework over that part of the Caboolture West Emerging Community Area, as identified on the map at Attachment A. The future planning framework will include approved detailed land use and infrastructure planning outlining how residential growth, infrastructure, services, transport networks, parks, centres, housing diversity, schools and environmental corridors should be delivered in an orderly and integrated manner. The framework will also have regard to the planning currently being undertaken for the adjoining Neighbourhood Development Plan No.1 Area
- protect State interests from adverse impacts arising from development in the Caboolture West Emerging Community Area until such time as detailed land use and infrastructure planning has been undertaken and approved.

Under section 27 of the *Planning Act 2016* I have decided to repeal TLPI 02/2022, with effect from the end of the day on Monday 13 March 2023.

Location of Area to which TLPI 02/2022 Applies

TLPI 02/2022 applies only to part of the Moreton Bay Regional Council local government area, namely the land identified as within TLPI 02/2022 area in Attachment A to TLPI 02/2022.

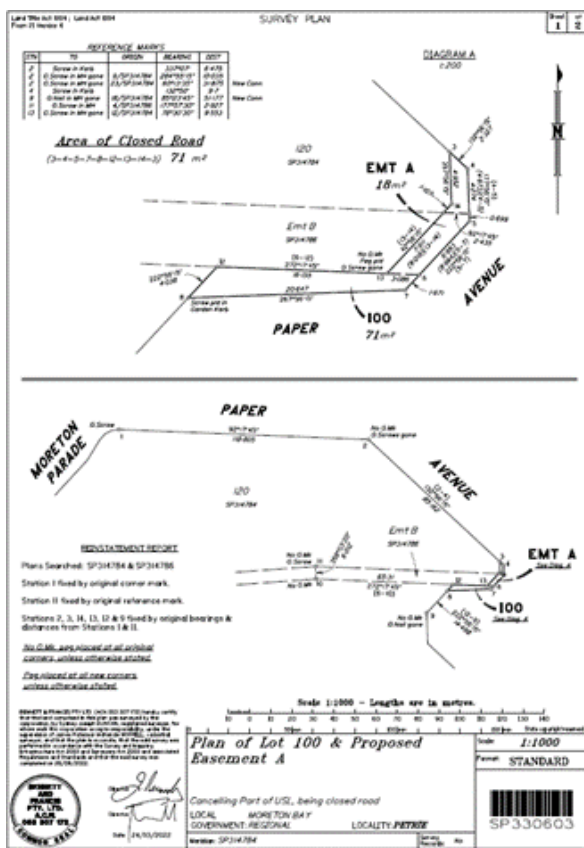

(1.1) Under section 23 of the QCA Act, I refer the Specified Monopoly Business Activities to the Authority for an investigation about pricing practices relating to those activities.

B. Section 24(1)(d) – Direction to make recommendations about stated matters

(1.1) Under section 24(1)(d) of the QCA Act, I direct the Authority to make recommendations about the following stated matters:

- Appropriate Prices and, for relevant WSSs, other prices including drainage prices, water harvesting prices and termination fees to be charged by the Businesses for the Price Path Period in relation to the Specified Monopoly Business Activities.
- appropriate price review triggers and other mechanisms in relation to Appropriate Prices, to manage the risks associated with material changes in Allowable Costs outside the control of the Businesses.

C. Section 24(1)(b) – Direction to consider stated matters

(1.1) Under section 24(1)(b) of the QCA Act, I direct the Authority to consider the following stated matters when conducting the investigation:

- the fixed and variable nature of the underlying costs in relation to tariff structures.
- the need to:
 - balance the legitimate commercial interests of the Businesses with the interests of their customers, and
 - where possible, provide revenue and pricing outcomes that are both simple and transparent for customers.

(c) Where the Authority considers that it has been demonstrated that customers have agreed to the costs and/or prices proposed by the Businesses and the Authority considers that the proposed prices are consistent with the requirements of this Referral, the Authority must have regard to these agreements in recommending appropriate prices.

(d) Where relevant, the findings of the Authority's March 2022 Report should be taken into account.

D. Consultation

(1.1) The Authority must undertake an open consultation process with relevant parties, as required by section 25 of the QCA Act, and consider submissions within the timetable for the delivery of the final report to the Treasurer detailed in paragraph E. Subject to the Authority's obligations in relation to confidential information, all reports and submissions should be made publicly available, including on the Authority's website.

E. Timing

(1.1) The notice given and published by the Authority under section 25 of the QCA Act on receipt of this Referral, should require submissions on proposed prices and associated costs (and supporting information) for each tariff group to be made to the Authority by the Businesses by no later than 30 November 2023.

(1.2) The Authority must report the results of its investigation to the Minister and me by providing:

- a draft report by no later than 30 June 2024; and
- a final report and recommendations by no later than 31 January 2025.

F. Other matters

(1.1) For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this Referral prevents the Businesses from negotiating full commercial prices to supply water other than for the Specified Monopoly Business Activities.

(1.2) The Authority may exercise all the powers under Part 6 of the QCA Act in undertaking the investigation under this Referral.
