NOTIFICATION OF REPEAL OF RESTRICTIONS ON GRANT OF MINING TENEMENTS UNDER THE *MINERAL RESOURCES ACT 1989* AND THE *GEO THERMAL ENERGY ACT 2010*

4. In accordance with section 115(1) of the Act, we direct the Board, in relation to Ports North and its subsidiaries, to:
- manage and deliver the design and construction of the Cairns Marine Precinct Common User Facility (CMP-CUF) in collaboration with the State;
 - own the CMP-CUF;
 - negotiate a Project Agreement with Shareholding Departments, with a view to finalising and executing this document by 26 September 2024;
 - take all reasonable steps to construct the full scope of the CMP-CUF including a 5000 tonne shiplift, 100 metre long wharf, two blast and paint sheds and three hardstand areas, with a targeted delivery timeframe in the calendar year 2028;
 - implement project reporting and governance arrangements as agreed with Shareholding Departments;
 - accept equity funding from the State for capital construction costs, with equity funding allocated to be recognised as an adjustment to contributed equity in the financial accounts of Ports North and the Department;
 - conduct an investigation, in close cooperation with Shareholding Departments, on the most appropriate operating model for the completed CMP-CUF and seek approval from Shareholding Ministers for its implementation;
 - do anything necessary, incidental, consequential or convenient to give effect to this Direction;
 - provide full cooperation and assistance to the State, the Shareholding Ministers and their respective advisors to implement this Direction;
 - give effect to any written request of the Director-General or Under Treasurer (or a departmental officer on the Director-General's or Under Treasurer's behalf), for the purposes of this Direction; and
 - where there is any ambiguity or doubt about the meaning or intent of this Direction, give effect to the interpretation of the Director-General as advised to the Board in a written clarifying statement.

6. Events involving IRB must have in attendance:
 - a. Rescue boats; and
 - b. Ambulance and paramedic services.
7. Operators and crew are to comply with any training or operating requirements contained within the certificate of registration for the IRB.
8. SLSQ must assess the operators and crew of IRB as competent in those areas of boat handling and marine safety related to the safe operation of an IRB prior to their participation in an event. SLSQ must keep a record of the assessment to include but not limited to:
 - a. Date of assessment;
 - b. Full name and contact details;
 - c. Qualifications, licences and experience;
 - d. Description of assessment and competency;
 - e. Name and contact details of the assessor.
9. Operators and crew of IRB are to receive a specific race briefing prior to each event in which they participate and must undertake any pre-race practice and training as required by SLSQ.
10. Events involving IRB are to be conducted in compliance with Championship event and safety plans.
11. Operators and crew of IRB must comply with all laws, rules, codes and guidelines applicable to the event and instructions from officials of the Championship.
