NOTIFICATION OF DANGER TO MARINE SAFETY

I, Captain David Ferguson, Acting Regional Harbour Master (Townsville), Maritime Safety Queensland, pursuant to the provision of section 197 of the Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016 declare that a person (other than those persons listed in Schedule A) must not anchor, berth, moor or operate a powered ship, or type of powered ship, within the waters described in Schedule B, as doing so would endanger marine safety.
