

- \$350 million Mackay Port Access, Bruce Highway to Mackay Slade Point Road, construct new two lane road (jointly funded with the Australian Government)
- \$187.4 million towards Walkerston Bypass (jointly funded with the Australian Government)
- \$56.5 million Bruce Highway, Emu Creek to Drays Road, various locations, widen formation (jointly funded with the Australian Government)
- \$31.4 million Bruce Highway, Bowen Connection Road to Champion Street intersection, widen pavement (jointly funded with the Australian Government)
