### **APPOINTMENT AS A DEPUTY PUBLIC INTEREST MONITOR**

The Queensland Government invites expressions of interest from suitably qualified persons for appointment as a Deputy Public Interest Monitor.

The role of a monitor is to oversee the application for, and use of, surveillance and covert search warrants under the *Crime and Corruption Act 2001* and the *Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000*. Other requirements involve statistical information gathering under the Criminal Code of the Commonwealth and the *Terrorism (Preventative Detention) Act 2005*, as well as responsibilities under the *Telecommunications Interception Act 2009*.

A monitor must have admission to practice as an Australian Lawyer and be able to appear before a court or tribunal at short notice. Persons appointed as a Deputy Public Interest Monitor cannot be involved in the prosecution or defence of criminal matters during their appointment.

Appointment is for 3 years duration. Remuneration will be paid on a fee for service basis.

- (b) The State (represented by Department of Health) and the Service must execute such instruments and make such applications to such relevant courts as is necessary to record the substitution of the State (represented by Department of Health) for the Service with respect to those causes of action identified in **clause 2(a)(i)(2)**.

### 3 Designation of Transfer or Other Dealing (s 273A(4))

The transfer under **clause 1.1** is subject to the condition that the designation for the transfer or other dealing as to all relevant assets and liabilities including the relevant assets and liabilities provided for in **clauses 1** and **2** of this Transfer Notice are to be accounted for as:

- (a) a non reciprocal transfer or other dealing;
- (b) a contribution by or distribution to owners by way of an adjustment against contributed equity in the relevant entity: and

  - (ii) to the extent that this would cause the transferor's accumulated surplus to reduce below \$0, the balance is to be recognised as an expense; and
- (c) the value attributed to the transfer or other dealing is the carrying value of the item as recorded in the accounts of the transferor, or the amount as agreed by the transferor and the transferee, immediately prior to the Effective Time,

or as otherwise determined by me in writing.
