

JOBSEEKER SUPPORT POOL: SUPPORTING QUEENSLANDERS TO GAIN LONG-TERM EMPLOYMENT

Imagine a program that aims to increase a jobseeker's employability skills to equip them to gain and maintain long-term employment. The Jobseeker Support Pool does just that...and more!

Available to Queenslanders who identify as young people aged 15-24 years, First Nations people, culturally and linguistically diverse people, people with disability or long-term unemployed (52 weeks or more), the Jobseeker Support Pool provides valuable support including:

- Delivery of career advice, job search techniques and job readiness skills.
- Delivery of accredited or non-accredited training packages.
- Delivery of financial assistance to address barriers to employment, including costs associated with:
 - Work Ready Checklist and Prepare yourself for work sessions
 - driving lessons
 - White Card, Blue Card and Yellow Card fees
 - machinery tickets or other licenses
 - funding to purchase identification
 - accredited short courses, including machinery, construction, hospitality and many more
 - uniforms and appropriate tools and equipment relevant to the chosen career path.
- Delivery of foundation skills including language, literacy and numeracy training where identified necessary.

The Jobseeker Support Pool helps to bridge the gap between jobseekers and employers, ensuring that individuals who are seeking employment have the necessary skills and training to succeed.
