

ONE-ON-ONE SUPPORT FOR JOBSEEKERS

Did you know that Back to Work Jobseeker Officers can offer one-on-one support to eligible jobseekers with a range of financial and non-financial assistance available through the Pre-employment Program (PEP)?

Back to Work Jobseeker Officers are located across the state and work with unemployed jobseekers to understand individual career goals, employment pathways and help jobseekers develop personalised plans. Specialised support can also include:

- resume writing, interview skills and online profile assistance
- understanding how to navigate the local job market
- Harrison Career Assessment Tool – which provides an in-depth analysis of an individual's interests, strengths and work preferences
- career and training advice linked to jobs in the region
- gap funding to remove barriers to employment, including licencing tickets, short courses, PPE and more
- access to 'true second chance' C3G (Certificate 3 Guarantee) Plus funding.

PEP is available to jobseekers who identify as belonging to one or more of the following groups:

- young people (aged 15-24 years)
- First Nations people
- culturally and linguistically diverse people
- people with disability
- long- term unemployed people (unemployed for 52 weeks or longer)
- Back to Work supported employees at risk of becoming unemployed.
