Cabinet exemptions	On 24 August 2023, the Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games approved an exemption from Regulatory Impact Statement (now IAS) for amendments to fisheries regulations to give effect to GBR related commitments to UNESCO regarding the phasing out of gillnet fishing, The approval acknowledged the importance of stakeholder consultation and engagement in the absence of a formal RIS and the department was requested to continue to engage with the fishing industry and relevant stakeholders on the policy changes.
