Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 5 August 2024

Area: South East Queensland

Locality: Offshore from Surfers Paradise Beach

Activity: Pacific Airshow Exclusion Zone

Mariners are advised that:

The Pacific Air Show event is to be staged over the Pacific Ocean adjacent Surfers Paradise Beach on 15-18 August 2024. The event will involve numerous flying and aerobatic demonstrations over an area of water 3655 m long and extending 1078m seaward from the beach between approximate positions latitude 27° 59.090' S, longitude 153 26.476' E and latitude 28° 01.060' S, longitude 153 26.697' E.

This area forms the marine exclusion zone, see attached map s1-563 where a person must not anchor, berth, moor or operate a ship, unless authorised to do so, during the days of the event.

The marine exclusion zone will be identified with floating buoys located at the perimeter's seaward boundaries. Water Police will patrol the exclusion zone to ensure that vessels do not enter the area.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the area


Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA2020 datum.
