Activity: Marine Pollution Exercise – Exercise Dumaresq 24

Mariners are advised that:

On Tuesday 29 October 2024 and Wednesday 30 October 2024 between the hours of 0700 and 1700 responders will be practicing the deployment of marine pollution response equipment on Currumbin Creek.

The deployment is part of the Australian Maritime Safety Authorities National Plan “Exercise Dumaresq 24”.

Maritime Safety Queensland vessels ‘Tingalpa’, ‘Kawana’, ‘Caniapa’ and Gold Coast Waterways Authority vessel ‘Tally’ will be operating in the areas between the Gold Coast Highway Bridge and Thrower Drive Bridge and can be contacted on VHF CH16/73.

Further information on the area the vessels and equipment will be operating can be found in Map S22-21-2.

Mariners are reminded that the waters of Currumbin Creek have a gazetted speed limit of 6 knots, and to navigate with caution in the area.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA2020 datum.
