Dredging operations will commence at the entrance to the Tweed River, Latitude. 28° 10.3′ S, Longitude. 153° 33.4′ E, from 8 July 2024 (subject to weather conditions). Dredging will operate 24 hours per day, 7 days a week for approximately 60 days.

Associated sand placement operations may take place at designated deposit locations between Bilinga to the North and Fingal to the South.
