


RATING	DESCRIPTION	MAPPING UNITS	COMMENT
1	Negligible salinity hazard with irrigation.	P2 T1, T4, T5, T6	Rating based on very low chloride levels in soils and general permeability of soils and rocks.
2	Very low salinity hazard with irrigation.	P1, P5 T2, T3	Rating based on sporadic occurrence of soils with high chloride levels. The clay soils of P1, P5 have lower sodicity and dispersibility than the clay soils in P3, P4. The alluvial clay soils within T2, T3 recorded occasional high chloride levels.
3	Low salinity hazard with irrigation.	A1, A2 P3 (western part), P4	Rating based on scalding and scattered medium chloride levels in sub soils of clay alluvia (A1, A2); and on scattered high chloride levels in clay sub soils of P3, P4 which have higher sodicity and dispersibility than the clay soils in P1, P5.
4	Moderate salinity hazard with irrigation.	P3 (eastern part), P6	Rating based on soils which generally contain high chloride levels and are strongly sodic with high dispersibility.

 Area considered most suited to irrigation, based on salinity hazard, soil characteristics, soil variability and depth, slopes, location and continuity of areas.
