in the State of Queensland, do hereby declare that:

1. **I/We am/are a primary producer who normally spends more than 50 per cent of my labour on, and derives more than 50 per cent of my gross income from primary production.**
2. I/We have undertaken, prior to applying for this declaration, a reasonable level of self reliance in drought management.
3. My/our property meets the mandatory one in ten to fifteen year rainfall deficiency criteria when comparing actual recorded rainfall during the previous 12 months to historical data.
4. No livestock have been introduced onto this property in the 3 month period prior to application for drought declaration (includes stock taken on for agistment).
5. In order to assess my application and make an informed decision on my property’s eligibility for a drought declaration, DAF may need to confirm the details provided on this form with the details previously provided as a Registered Biosecurity Entity. These details will not be accessed or used for any other purpose other than to assist in assessing this application. I consent to authorised officers accessing and confirming my details in the Biosecurity Entity Registration System.
6. I agree to provide any National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) data if applicable for the time period relevant to my application if requested. I understand that this information will only be used for assessment and compliance purposes related to processing and managing my application.
7. I understand that to access Queensland’s new drought assistance my property does not require a drought declaration.
8. I understand that if my Individually Drought Property Declaration is approved it does not automatically allow access to the Drought Relief Assistance Scheme and I understand that the Drought Relief Assistance Scheme is being phased out and new drought preparedness assistance is now available.
9. I understand that any applications submitted under the Drought Relief Assistance Scheme may be subject to audit by DAF or its agents in order to determine compliance with scheme guidelines.
10. By signing this declaration, I understand that I may be asked to provide further information in regards to my application and/or the material submitted with my application and that I may be requested to allow a property inspection by DAF as part of the application process or a future audit process to determine compliance with guidelines.
11. The information I have provided in this application and in supporting documentation is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate. I understand that providing inaccurate, untrue or misleading information may be a breach of criminal law, for which serious penalties may apply. I also understand that if any information I have provided in the application or supporting documentation is found to be inaccurate, untrue or misleading, legal action may be taken against me, including action to recover any financial assistance you may have incorrectly received.
