



Drought Relief Assistance Scheme Freight subsidy application: animals purchased for restocking

Instructions

Applications must be lodged with Brisbane office **within 6 months** of the date of movement.

Only stock purchased after the date of drought revocation of the property are eligible for freight subsidy.

Tax invoices for the purchase and freight of the livestock must be provided, along with the waybills used to transport the stock to the home property.

This freight subsidy is available for 24 months after the property's drought-declared status is officially revoked.

The personal information you provide in this form is being collected by the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries and confirmed through department's Biosecurity Entity Registration System, for the purpose of assisting authorised departmental officers to process and assess your application. Some information about your property's drought-declared status and your access to assistance under the Drought Relief Assistance Scheme may be provided to the following Queensland Government agencies for the purpose of assessing your eligibility for drought assistance packages:

- Department of Resources,
- Department of Transport and Main Roads
- Department of Education; and
- Queensland Rural and Industry Development Authority.

E. Applicant's declaration

in the State of Queensland, being the owner of the stock referred to on this form, do hereby declare that:

1. I am a primary producer who normally spends more than 50 per cent of my labour on, and derives more than 50 per cent of my gross income from, a primary production enterprise.
2. I am a property owner, sharefarmer or lessee in the grazing industry (beef cattle, sheep, dairy cattle, goats, deer or horses that are not normally hand fed).
3. No livestock were introduced onto this property while it was drought-declared or during the 3 month period prior to this drought declaration (includes stock taken on for agistment). If livestock were introduced, it is in accordance with the eligibility criteria as outlined in the *Transport of livestock purchased for restocking freight subsidy guidelines*.
4. My property was revoked from drought declaration prior to the purchase and introduction of any livestock. If livestock have been introduced while the property was drought-declared, it was in accordance with the eligibility criteria as outlined in the *Transport of livestock purchased for restocking freight subsidy guidelines*.
5. I have transported the purchased livestock within 24 months of the revocation of my property's drought declaration.
6. The purchased livestock do not increase stock numbers on my property beyond normal carrying capacity.
7. The distance claimed for the transport of purchased livestock was the shortest practicable route.
8. The purchase of the livestock and the freight costs have been paid in their entirety and the necessary tax invoices are attached.
9. I have not received a Drought Preparedness Grant, a Drought Ready and Recovery Loan or an Emergency Drought Loan through the Queensland Rural and Industry Development Authority (QRIDA) and understand the once I access these assistance measures through QRIDA I will no longer be eligible for DRAS.
10. I understand that by receiving a payment through DRAS, I will not be able to access the Drought Preparedness Grant, the Drought Ready and Recovery Loan or the Emergency Drought Loan through QRIDA in the same financial year as the DRAS payment has been paid.
11. In order to assess my claim and make an informed decision on my eligibility for drought assistance, I understand and agree that DAF may need to consult with QRIDA to verify any assistance previously received through QRIDA that may impact on my eligibility for DRAS.
12. In order to assess my claim and make an informed decision on my eligibility for drought assistance, DAF will need to confirm the details provided on this form with the details previously provided as a Registered Biosecurity Entity. These details will not be accessed or used for any other purpose other than to assist in assessing this claim. I consent to authorised officers accessing and confirming my details in the Biosecurity Entity Registration System.
13. I agree to provide National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) data for the time period relevant to my application if requested. I understand that this information will only be used for assessment and compliance purposes related to processing and managing my application.
14. I understand that any applications submitted under the Drought Relief Assistance Scheme may be subject to audit by DAF or its agents in order to determine compliance with scheme guidelines. By signing this declaration, I understand that I may be asked to provide further information in regards to my application and/or the material submitted with my application and that I may be requested to allow a property inspection by DAF as part of an audit process to determine compliance with scheme guidelines.
15. The information I have provided in this application and in supporting documentation is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate. I understand that providing inaccurate, untrue or misleading information may be a breach of criminal law, for which serious penalties may apply. I also understand that if any information I have provided in the application or supporting documentation is found to be inaccurate, untrue or misleading, legal action may be taken against me, including action to recover the subsidy.

F. Establishing restocking credits

This form must be completed when lodging your initial restocking application following the revocation of your property’s drought-declared status to identify and verify restocking credits. This is required after each revocation period.

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Calculating restocking credits

Sales dockets or kill sheets showing the type of stock and dates of sale or slaughter are required and should be attached on your initial restocking application.

The number of stock eligible for freight subsidy (restocking credits) is calculated at 75% of the total number of all livestock sold. This includes those sold from agistment and those sold from feedlots during the period of drought declaration and during the 2 month period prior to declaration.
