



NOTICE TO MARINERS

195 (T) of 2024

Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 24 April 2024

Area: Noosa pilotage area
Locality: Noosa River, Noosa Heads
Activity: Beach Nourishment Dredging Works

Mariners are advised that:

dredging works will be conducted within the Noosa River Mouth with a scheduled commencement of Tuesday, 2nd of April and continue until the end of July 2024.

During dredging operations, a floating pipeline will be located within the mouth. The pipeline will be marked with yellow hazard marker buoys 20m from dredge, then at intervals of 30m on float line. Mariners are advised to stay away from the dredge end and are advised not to cross between hazard markers.

The dredging will be confined within the operating area towards the centre of the river, however ancillary equipment including the workboat Darnley and dredging pipeline may be located to the South and East of the operating area.

Mariners are advised to seek a safe sailing route, steering clear of the dredge and pipeline.

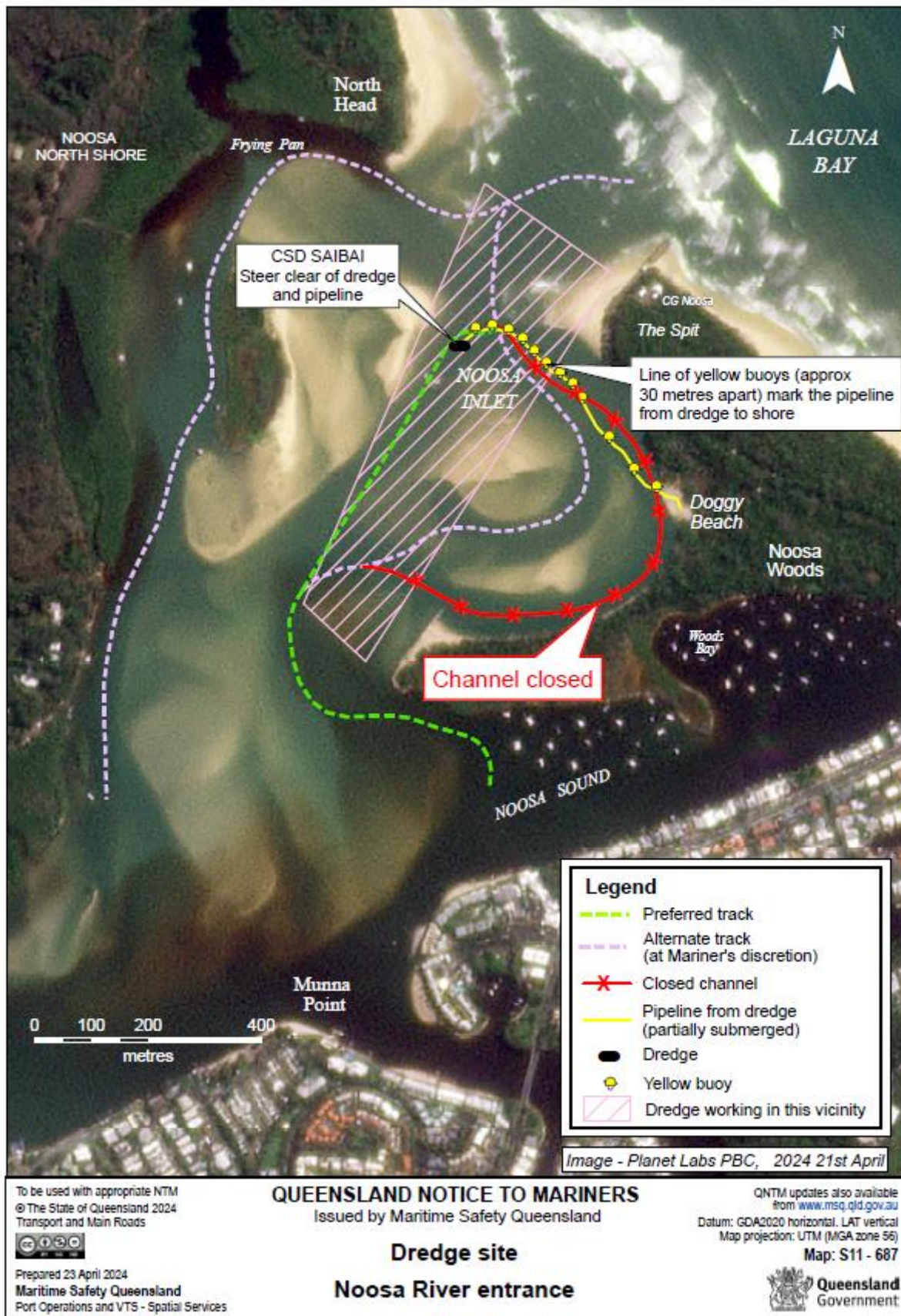
The passage along Doggy Beach will be fully closed from 24th of April 2024 onwards. Mariners are advised to use alternative routes. Mariners proceeding near the work area, or using the channel dredged by the dredger, should proceed with caution and be keep a lookout for pipelines, anchors and wires below water level.

Mariners are advised to contact the dredge operator on CH 16, should the dredge or pipeline impede their safe passage.
