DEADLINES:

APPOINTMENT SUBMISSIONS: before 12 noon on a Tuesday for that Friday's edition.

OTHER SUBMISSIONS: before 12 noon on a Wednesday for that Friday's edition.

PAYMENTS: before close of business on a Wednesday for that Friday's edition.

1. Type in the quotation number **GAZ000XX/15** or **VAC000XX/15** as shown in the right hand top corner of your quotation.

3. Once payment has been made, the Gazette Team will be notified via email from Smart Service Queensland.
