 - (c) the impacts the temporary full supply level may have on the water security of the dam; and
 - (d) whether the temporary full supply level would affect the safety of the dam; and
 - (e) other matters the Minister considers appropriate.
5. This temporary full supply level declaration for North Pine Dam takes effect on the day this notice is published in the Gazette.
6. This temporary full supply level declaration for North Pine Dam ceases to have effect on the day that is 6 months after this notice is published in the Gazette.
