NOTIFICATION OF DANGER TO MARINE SAFETY

I, Captain David Ferguson, Acting Regional Harbour Master (Townsville), Maritime Safety Queensland, pursuant to the provision of section 197 of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016* declare that a person (other than those persons listed in Schedule A) must not anchor, berth, moor or operate a powered ship, or type of powered ship, within the waters described in Schedule B, as doing so would endanger marine safety.

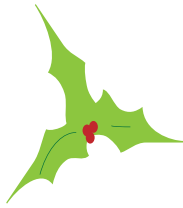

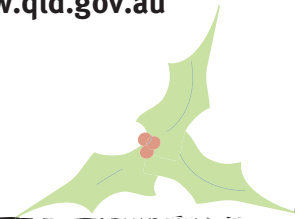
