




I commend The State for reforms on the *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2010* (PID Act).


I am pleased to provide recommendations in my personal capacity and as a whistle-blower. In order to demonstrate the value of my recommendations, I provide generalised context of my case herein.

PART A: FACTUAL BACKGROUND









(c)	Provision of legal support for whistle-blowers as a fundamental right upon whistleblowing. I was,
(d)	and am, unable to procure any legal advice and do not qualify for The State's support services, Equal protections to all employment types. I was turned away by 13 lawyers, each at the point of understanding that I was a contractor. The expert lawyers were the most recognised employment lawyers throughout Australia and informed me that they could not assist a contractor under current laws. As in my case, I am a contractor in a team of contractors, whistleblowing against contractors. My disclosure founded serious and systemic corruption which could only have been founded by a contractor due to the nature of the corruption. Awarding equal protections to whistle-blowers regardless of their employment classification will support greater accountability and integrity of the public sector,
