- (c) amend the Mooloolaba/Alexandra Headland Local Plan Elements map (Figure 7.2.20A) to include additional road and pedestrian linkages, additional active street frontages, additional Gateway / Entry Points and add new Key Site 3 – Club Eatery;

- (d) amend the Mooloolaba/Alexandra Headland Local Plan Precincts map (LPM34), to expand the hospitality precinct to include new Key Site 3 – Club Eatery and create a new Mooloolaba Heart Street Activation precinct along Walan Street; and
- (e) amend the Mooloolaba/Alexandra Headland local plan table of assessment relating to business activities in the High density residential zone for the new Mooloolaba Heart Street Activation precinct along Walan Street.

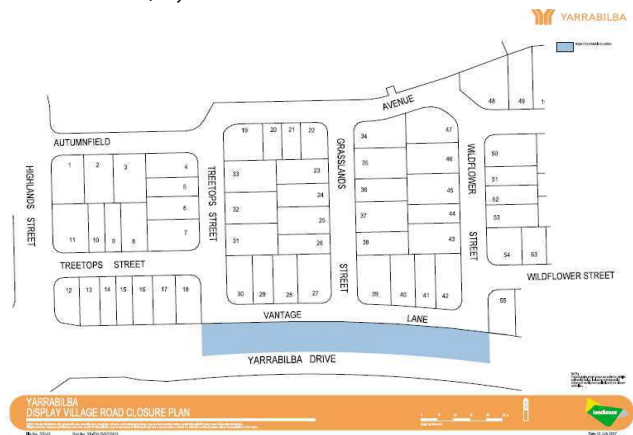

Under the provisions of section 124 of the *Economic Development Act 2012* (the Act) the Minister for Economic Development Queensland (the MEDQ) may perform functions or exercise powers for a road in a priority development area the MEDQ considers necessary or desirable to perform its other functions.

On 28 June 2013 in Gazette number 45, MEDQ declared part of 6 Roads in the Yarrabilba Priority Development Area, temporarily closed.
